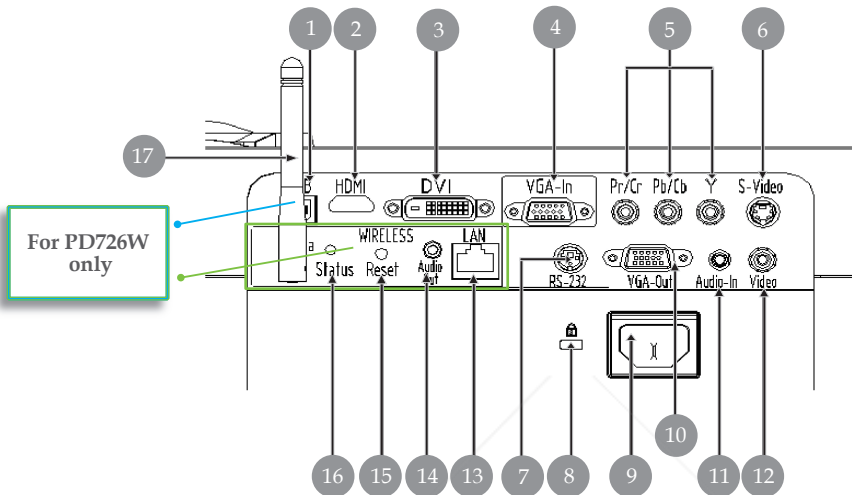

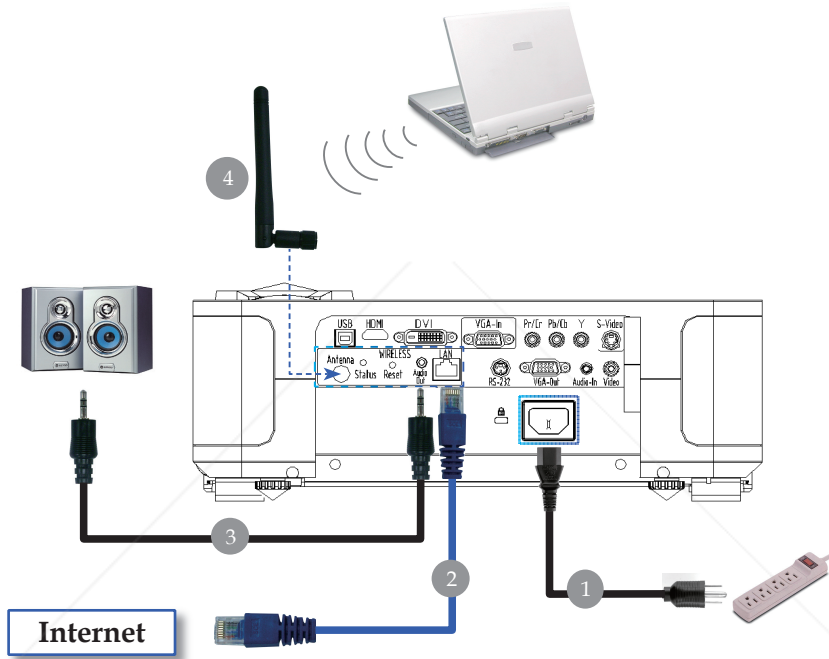

Installation

Connecting the Projector

For Wireless function



- 1.....Power Cord
- 2.....Lan Cable
- 3.....Audio Cable Jack/Jack
- 4.....Antenna

(for PD726W only, need to attach the antenna by user)

User Controls

Color

- ▶ Press "Color" to adjust the color temperature of image.

Contrast

- ▶ Press "Contrast" to control the difference between the lightest and darkest parts of the picture.

VGA

- ▶ Press "VGA" to change source to VGA-In connector. This connector supports Analog RGB, YPbPr (480p/576p/720p/1080i), YCbCr (480i/576i) and RGBsync.

Component

- ▶ Press "Component" to change source to component connector. This connector supports YPbPr (480p/576p/720p/1080i) and YCbCr (480i/576i)

Video

- ▶ Press "Video" to change source to Composite Video source.

S-Video

- ▶ Press "S-Video" to change source to S-Video source.

DVI

- ▶ Press "DVI" to change source to DVI connector. This connector supports Digital RGB, Analog RGB, YPbPr (480p/576p/720p/1080i), YCbCr (480i/576i) and HDCP signal.

HDMI

- ▶ Press "HDMI" to change source to HDMI. This connector can support to carry all standard and high-definition consumer electronics video formats.

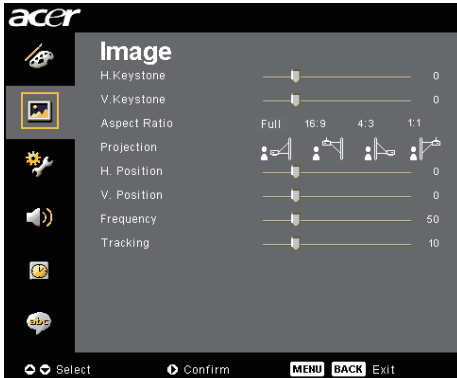


Image (Computer / Video Mode)

H. Keystone (Horizontal Keystone)

- ▶ Press the ◀ or ▶ button to adjust image distortion horizontally and makes a squarer image.

V. Keystone (Vertical Keystone)

- ▶ Press the ◀ or ▶ button to adjust image distortion vertically and makes a squarer image.

Aspect Ratio

Use this function to choose your desired aspect ratio.

- ▶ Full : Resize image to fit full screen.
- ▶ 16:9 : The input source will be scaled to fit the width of the screen and narrowed the height to make the displayed image becomes 16:9 ratio.
- ▶ 4:3 : The input source will be scaled to fit the projection screen and becomes 4:3 ratio.
- ▶ 1:1 : Keep image at the center of screen with its original pixel resolution without scaling.

Projection

- ▶  **Front-Desktop**

The factory default setting.

- ▶  **Front-Ceiling**

When you select this function, the projector turns the image upside down for ceiling-mounted projection.

- ▶  **Rear-Desktop**

When you select this function, the projector reverses the image so you can project behind a translucent screen.

- ▶  **Rear-Ceiling**

When you select this function, the projector reverses and turns the image upside down at same time. You can project from behind a translucent screen with ceiling mounted projection.

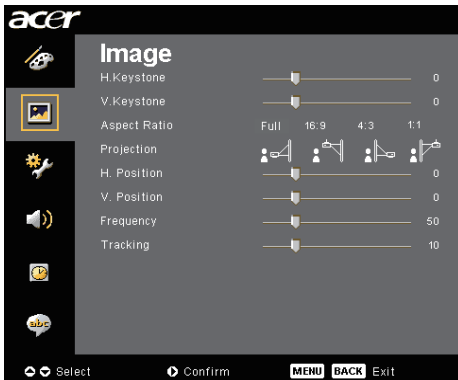


Image (Computer / Video Mode)



❖ "H. Position", "V. Position", "Frequency" and "Tracking" functions are not supported under DVI and Video mode.

H. Position (Horizontal Position)

- ▶ Press the ◀ to move the image left.
- ▶ Press the ▶ to move the image right.

V. Position (Vertical Position)

- ▶ Press the ◀ to move the image down.
- ▶ Press the ▶ to move the image up.

Frequency

"Frequency" changes the display data frequency to match the frequency of your computer's graphic card. If you experience a vertical flickering bar, use this function to make an adjustment.

Tracking

"Tracking" synchronizes the signal timing of the display with the graphic card. If you experience an unstable or flickering image, use this function to correct it.



❖ "Sharpness" functions is not supported under DVI and Computer mode.

Sharpness

Adjusts the sharpness of the image.

- ▶ Press the ◀ to decrease the sharpness.
- ▶ Press the ▶ to increase the sharpness.

Signal Type

Press the ▶ or ◀ button to change source to RGB, YPbPr or YCbCr.

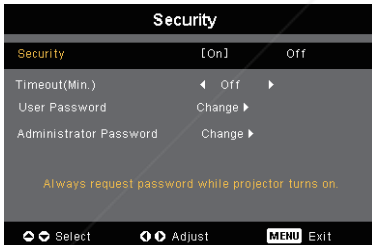


Lamp Reminding

Choose this function to show or to hide warning message when the changing lamp message is displayed. The message will show up 30 hours before end of life.

Security

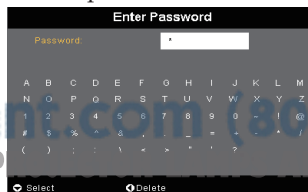
Press (▶) to start "Security" setting. If the "Security" function is enabled, your must enter "Administrator Password" first before Security setting.



Security

This projector provides an excellent security function for the administrator to manage the usage of the projector.

- ▶ Select "On" to enable the security function. User have to enter password depending on the "Security Mode". Please refer to "User Password" section for details.
- ▶ Select "Off" then user can switch on the projector without password.



Once the security function is enabled, the projector will request user to enter password when switch on the projector or enter security setting. Both "User Password" and "Administrator Password" can be accepted for this dialogue.

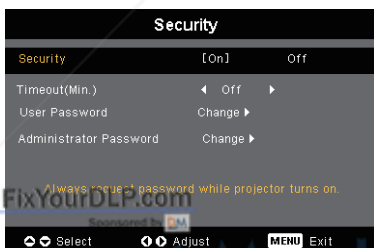

The projector provide two options of "Security Mode".

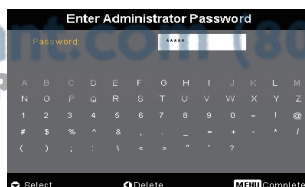
- ▶ Select "Request password only after plugging power cord", the project will request user to input password only for the first time plugging on power cord of the projector.
- ▶ Select "Always request password while projector turns on", user have to input password every time when switching on the projector.



Administrator Password

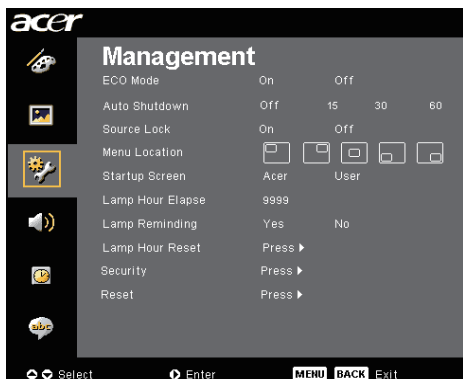
"Administrator Password" can be accepted by both "Enter Administrator Password" and "Enter Password" dialogues.

- ▶ Press (Enter) to change "Administrator Password". Projector will request "Administrator Password" before changing password.



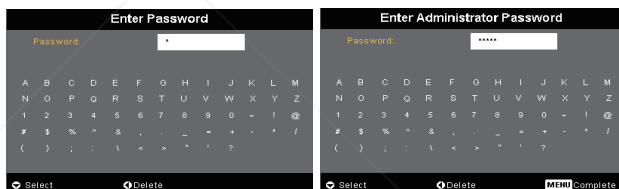
- ▶ The factory default of "Administrator Password" is "1234".

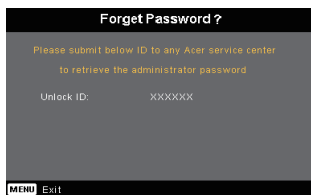


Management (Computer / Video Mode)

If user or administrator forgot "User Password" or even "Administrator Password", do the following to retrieve the "Administrator Password":




1. Press "MENU" for more than 4 seconds when any of "Enter Password" or "Enter Administrator Password" dialogue is currently displayed.



2. Write down the "Unlock ID" and contact with Acer service center. They will give you new Administrator Password according to the Unlock ID.
3. Once the new "Administrator Password" retrieved from Acer has been logged into the projector, old "Administrator Password" will be replaced by the new password.



Reset

Press the  button after choosing "Yes" to return the display parameters on all menus to the factory default settings.

Wireless projection

Introduction

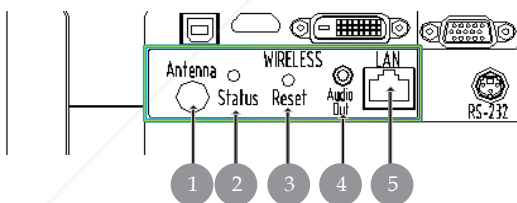
This section will introduce wireless projection function for this projector. The wireless projection function is only available for the model which is equipped with integrated Acer Wireless Presentation Gateway (WPG) module. Acer WPG enables multiple users to connect to an Acer projector wirelessly. This eliminates the need to plug and unplug cables, enabling more efficient use of meeting time, especially when there is more than one presenter in a meeting.

To perform wireless projection, you have to change the input source type to "Wireless" by pressing the "Wireless" button on the remote control or the "Source" button on the control panel or remote control.

- CPU: Intel® Pentium® III at 750 MHz or equivalent with 128 MB of RAM
- Wireless LAN: IEEE 802.11b/g enabled

3	Reset button	A quick press on the the Reset button will reset the WPG without changing any user's settings. Press and hold Reset button for more than 4 seconds to reset the WPG to its factory default settings.
4	Audio-out jack	For outputting audio signals received wirelessly from the PC.
5	RJ-45 Ethernet jack	For connecting the WPG to the Internet via a LAN.
